Scope of the Journal: The articles must address the issues relating to Public Service and Policy. Articles from different branches of knowledge will also be welcomed if they have any direct or indirect relation to the public service and policy. Articles must have relevance for generating some important policy implications.

Article type: Journal will comprise research articles, general articles or commentary on important issues and book reviews. The contributions should be original and scientifically written with citation of proper sources/literature. Plagiarism will be checked very strictly.

Periodicity: (Half-Yearly). January and July

Refereeing and Editing: This will be a peer reviewed journal. After submission an article will be reviewed by at least one specialist and also by the editorial board members. To avoid any biases, the process of reviewing will keep the names of author and reviewers confidential.

Footnotes and endnotes should not be used. If necessary, a general 'Explanatory Note' can be given at the end of the article.

References for all articles go together at the end of the journal. References should be set out using the following format:

Copyright: An article is accepted on the basis that it has not been previously published or under publication anywhere. On acceptance, copyrights will be automatically transferred to the publisher.

Submission of article: Articles are required to be submitted through mail only (at editor.fairlawns@yahoo.in) as doc file. PDF will not be accepted. Figures are to be sent as JPEG or TIFF. However, larger files have to be sent through CD/DVD.
