Q. No. 1	Is it true that there has been a tendency on the part of industries to use trainees under Apprentice Scheme as "Workers" in industry? If it permissible? If no, how this tendency can be checked and what action can be taken under relevant Act/Rules against this violations.		
Q. No. 2	What is the different between Industrial Training Institute(ITI) and Industrial Training Centre. Is aptitude test compulsory before admission? What aspects should be kept in view while taking aptitude test for admission to ITI/ITC. Should change of trade be allowed to trainees within 1-2 months of admission on the basis of aptitudes of a candidate.		
Q. No. 3	What are the objectives of apprentice training Scheme? Discuss the status of apprentice training scheme in Himachal Pradesh. How far this scheme is successful in public sector units in Himachal Pradesh.		
Q. No. 4	What are the qualification for being engaged as an apprentice. What are the necessary obligations on the part of employers and apprentices as prescribed in the Apprenticeship Act. It is obligatory on the part of employer to offer employment to an apprentice. Discuss relevant provisions in this regard.		
Q. No. 5	Do you think that self-financing courses started in I.T.I. Is have made I.T.Is self reliant and enabled them to impart quality education. If not, can you suggest some other model to improve quality of technical education.		
Q. No. 6	DGE&T has been adding new courses for I.T.Is as per the requirement of industries. What new courses would you suggest for introduction keeping in view the requirement of industries in Himachal Pradesh. The course content, duration etc. of the course(s) may be discussed in brief.		
Q. No. 7	What provisions had been made under Factory Act with regard to cleanliness, disposal of waste and affluent, ventilation, temperature etc. to take care of health of the workers.
