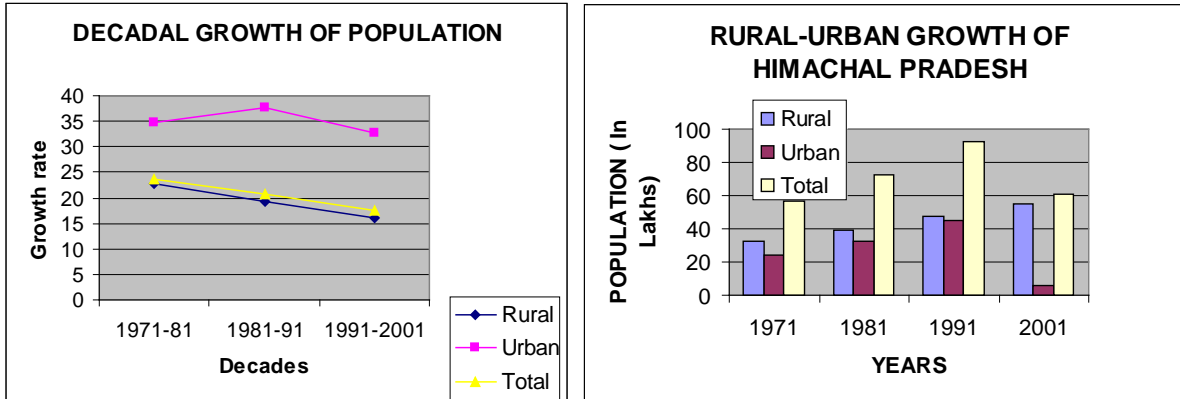


Population

The population of Himachal has been increasing continuously over the years. However the growth rate of total population shows a decreasing trend over the last three decades. In 2001, the total population of H.P was about 60, 77,900 out of which 30, 87,940 were males (51 %) and 29,89,960 (49%) were females. The rural population was on the higher side 90.20% and urban 9.80%. The percentage share of urban population has been increasing continuously over the years with figures of 7.61% in 1981, 8.69% in 1991 and 9.80% in 2001 census. The percentage of SC/ST population was 24.72 and 4.02 respectively.



The number of women per 1000 men (sex ratio) which was 958 in 1971 increased to 968 in 2001. In Hamirpur district it was 1099 in 2001. Density per sq. Km as per population census is increased from 62 to 109 in 1971 to 2001. Birth rate and death rate have been decreasing both in rural and urban areas over the years. The birth rate in 2008 for rural areas was 18.2 as compared to 12.1 in urban areas. The total marital fertility rate of H.P was 4.7 as compared to All India 4.3 in 2008. The Residential houses has also increased from 9,59,453 to 12,30,237.

Composition of Population

Composition of population according to age has been changing over last four decades which has many repercussions in planning and programme for the State .

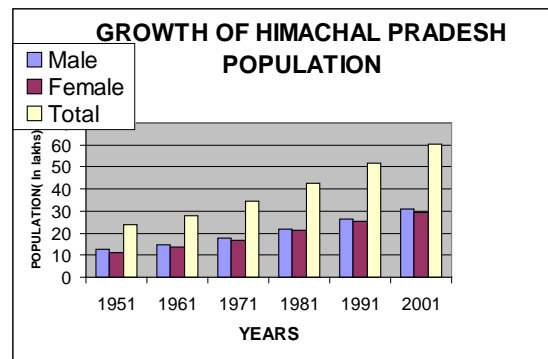

Literacy rate

In 2001 the overall literacy rate was about 76% with male literacy rate of 85% and female literacy rate 67%. As per the census 2001 the highest literacy rate both male and female was in Hamirpur district 90.2% & 75.7% respectively. Literacy percentage among Scheduled castes has increased from 53.2% in 1991 to 70.3% in 2001, 80.0% males & 60.4% were females in 2001 census. 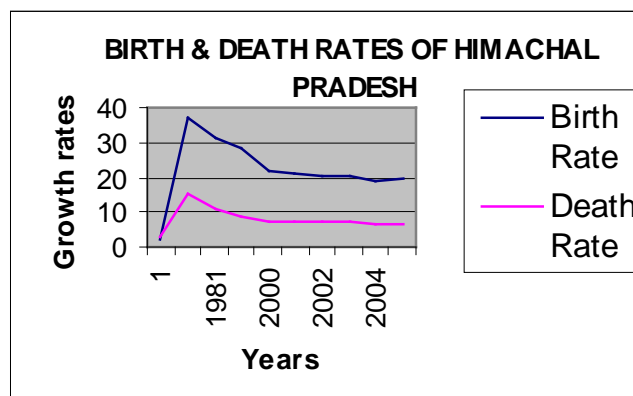
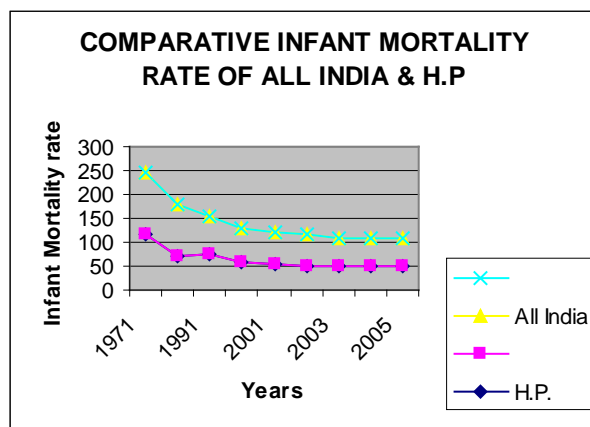
