**NOTIFICATION**

In continuation to this Department's notification of even number dated 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2006, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to amend/modify the Term "Corridor of Impact" of the Section 1.2.2 of the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy (R&R Policy) to the following extent:-

**1.2.2 Terms:-**

**Corridor of Impact** Width of corridor required for the construction of road, service lane, drain, footpath, access, tree plantation and for safety zone. The corridor of impact for the project *shall be as per Detailed Design requirement and in case of non availability of same, broadly* in Open and Built-up areas it would be 13 meters in Hilly terrain & 15 meters in Rolling terrain, however in built-up areas where it is not possible it would be 9 meters in Hilly terrain & 10 meters in rolling terrain.

Rest of the provision in the R&R Policy will remain the same.
