*	<p>The total cadre strength of IAS Officers in H.P. is 129 against which only 82 Officers are in position. The data regarding 75 senior duty posts which exist in H.P. shows that the number of Officers who have retired or gone to Government of India is 3 and 12 respectively. If the transfers made on the basis of these two factors is included and 11 Officers who have been transferred by the present Government after their initial postings then 26 Officers have been transferred during the tenure of this Government without completing the tenure and in terms of percentage it comes to 65%. These two factors i.e. retirements and postings on deputation to Government of India are not in the hands of the State Government yet the stability of tenure is 65% which is pretty high. If the transfers made on the basis of above two factors is excluded then only 11 Officers have been transferred and the stability in terms of percentage comes to 85%. In other words 85% of Officers have the stability of tenure and they have not be distrubed.</p>
